If you show up with three bags during an embargo, you will be forced to leave one behind or ship it via cargo, a disaster we help you avoid at  [+1-888-283-3615](tel:+1-888-283-3615). **Check for regional baggage embargoes weeks before your holiday trip.** To verify if your destination has a holiday bag limit, please dial  [+1-888-283-3615](tel:+1-888-283-3615) today.
